<b>Hierarchy</b>	cutting of the taproot causes the destruction of all other parts	unity of the root maintained in supplementary dimension	autonomous. Loosely interconnected parts
<b>Operation</b>	imitation of the world		Is it working? How is it working (for me)? Is something coming through?
<b>Unity</b>	Linear: everything turns around a single axis	Cyclical: unity within the supplementary dimension (e.g. dimension of knowledge or of sentence)	Unitary idea is missing
<b>Multiplicity</b>	missing: it has been eliminated by dualism	rules of combination reduce the growth of multiplicity	multiplicity is achieved by subtracting the one from the existent: n-1
